The Commissioners appointed on the petition of Henry A. Still to view the way for altering Bloom's Road near the State Line, this day make their report and it appearing to the Court that the proprietors of the land through which the said Road will run waive all right to damages, it is ordered that the said petitioner Henry A. Still have the right to alter said Road as proposed and that the old Road be discontinued from the time the new Road be put in good repair and be fit for use.

Ordered that the Commissioners heretofore appointed to examine the South Lanes Bridge report as to the propriety of dispensing with said bridge and substituting in lieu thereof a ferry at the same or some other place across the Blackwater river -
