Williams charged with maliciously unlawfully beating Patrick Rowe with intention in so doing to maim, disfigure, disable or kill the said Patrick Rowe this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into before a Justice of the Peace of this County & was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County; And Thompson surveyor witness was sworn and examined and the witness to his Counsel fully heard. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case, are of opinion that the said James J. Williams ought to be tried for the said offence wherein he is charged, at the next Term of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for this County; And thereupon on the motion of the said James J. Williams he is allowed to give Bail himself to be bonded in the sum of one thousand dollars with three securities in the sum of three hundred and thirty three and a third dollars each; And Thompson the said James J. Williams with John M. Guley, Harrison D. Moore and Anthony McRowee his securities, here in Court severally acknowledges themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia; that is to say, the said James J. Williams in the sum of one thousand dollars; and the said John M. Guley, Harrison D. Moore and Anthony McRowee in the sum of three hundred and thirty three and a third dollars each, to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements; and for the use of the said Commonwealth's vendors; Upon this condition that if the said James J.
