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Thereof ~~is~~ ^{with} his trial for the offence ~~for~~ which he stands charged and shall do and submit to what on the said Court shall be ordered and adjudged and shall not depart without leave of the Court. Then this Recognizance to be void, or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Be it remembered that Patrick Rowe here in Court acknowledges himself to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of Three hundred and thirty three and a half dollars, to be levied of his goods and chattels, Lands and Tenements and for the use of the Commonwealth levies.
