Bonkin, doth order that the Overseers of the Poor of this County be authorized to purchase the said tract of land upon the terms recommended by the Commissioners in their report: and also that the said Overseers of the Poor be authorized to sell such part of said tract of land as is recommended by the said Commissioners in their report: provided they can sell the same at the same rate for which they purchased the original tract.
