Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 8th day of March 1850, from John Boykin and Caroline his wife, Saml. Kelles, Jas. Kelles and Charles T. Kelles of the one part and William V. Hood of the other part. conveying 27 acres of Land. was presented in the office on the 20th day of May 1850, as to the said John Boykin, Saml. Kelles, Jas. Kelles and Charles T. Kelles by the oaths of Saml. Kelles and Wm. R. Stephenson two of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and in the said office on the 17th day of June 1850. said deed was wholly proved as to the said abovesaid parties by the oath of Thos. J. Bister another subscribing witness thereto, and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 13th day of April 1850, from William D. Hood and Eona his wife, of the one part to Wm. R. Stephenson of the other part - conveying Land. was acknowledged by said Hood in the office on the 17th day of June 1850, and together with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the said Eona before two Justices of the peace, admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 5th day of January 1850, from Theophilus Field of the one part to Francis T. Ridley of the other part - conveying Land. was presented in the office on the 17th day of June 1850, and together with the Certificate of the acknowledgment of the said Field before two Justices of the peace admitted to record.

Receipt dated May 27th 1847 from Godwin Parker to Wiley Parker, his grandson, for said rents of Land due him, was acknowledged in the office on the 17th day of June 1850, by the said Godwin Parker and admitted to record.

Boykin, of the one part to the Owners of the poor of this County of the other part - conveying 142 1/2 acres of Land adjoining the Poorhouse. was proved in the office on the 17th day of June 1850, as to the said Boykin by the oaths of Saml. Bonner, James W. Spaulding and S. Jimmie Wilson, three of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and admitted to record.

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Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 10th day of June 1850, from Francis M. Boykin, of the one part to the Owners of the poor of this County of the other part - conveying 142 1/2 acres of Land adjoining the Poorhouse. was proved in the office on the 17th day of June 1850, as to the said Boykin by the oaths of Saml. Bonner, James W. Spaulding and S. Jimmie Wilson, three of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and admitted to record.
