 with Patrick Doles and Harrison Jones their securities, Certificate
 is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the estate
 of the said Francis Lenox deceased, with the will annexed in due
 form.

Ordered that John R. Stephens, A. A. Drew and Surgeon Linn being
 first sworn before a Justice of the peace do appraise in
 current money all the personal estate of Francis Lenox dec'd
 and return the same under their hands to the Court.
