

On the motion of Thomas H. Urquhart, ordered that Levi C. Waller trustee of
 # the said Waller's children pay to him sixteen dollars, the amount of
 his medical account.

The Court doth appoint Allen H. Cotton, Captain and William Cobb, John Gardner
 Darius Johnson, Simon Lewis and Joshua Cumber privates of a patrol, to patrol
 and visit for the term of one month in the districts of the back of the
 # River, all negro quarters and other places suspected of having therein
 unlawful assemblies, or such slaves as may stroll from one
 plantation to another without permission.

On the petition of Robert and Benjamin Taylor descendants of a female of the
 # Nottoway tribe of Indians, the Commissioners appointed to ascertain the
 interest of the said Robert and Benjamin Taylor intestate held in trust for
 the benefit of the said tribe of Indians this day made his report, and the
 cause coming on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and
 the report of Commissioners Worrell and was argued by counsel: On
 consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Thomas B.
 # Worrell, Abner R. Stephenson and Davis Barrett who are hereby appointed
 Commissioners for that purpose shall set apart by bonds and allot to
 the said Robert and Benjamin Taylor each one sixteenth part of the land held
 in common for the Nottoway tribe of Indians, and that the said Indian
 trustees pay to the said Robert & Benj^r Taylor each the sum of \$18.00
 their part of the fund now in hand, and leave is reserved to the said
 petitioners hereafter to apply for their portion of the fund now in suit.
 And the Commissioners are directed to report to court in order
 to a final decree

On the petitions of Edwin Sumner, Rebecca Woodson, and Caroline Bogman
 descendants of females of the Nottoway tribe of Indians, the Commission-
 # appointees to ascertain the interest of the said Edwin Sumner, Rebecca W.
 and Caroline Bogman in the estate held in trust for the benefit of the
 tribe of Indians, this day made his report, and the cause coming on again
 to be heard on the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioners
 Worrell, were argued by counsel, on consideration whereof the Court
 doth adjudge, order and decree that Thomas B. Worrell, Abner R.
 # Stephenson and Davis Barrett, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for
 that purpose, shall set aside by bonds and allot to Edwin Sumner, Rebecca
 Woodson and Caroline Bogman each one sixteenth part in value of the
 tract of land held in common for the Nottoway tribe of Indians, and
 that the said Indian trustees pay to the said Edwin Sumner, Rebecca
 Woodson and Caroline Bogman each the sum of \$18.00, their part of
 the fund now in hand and leave is reserved to the said petitioners
 hereafter to apply for their portion of the fund now in suit; and
 the Commissioners are directed to report to court in order to a
 final decree

The last will and Testament of James B. Urquhart dec'd was this day proved
 by the oaths of John Boykin and John Powers two of the subscribing
 witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion Richard
