Ordered that the clerk register Poling Gurley, Lucy Gurley, Mary Gurley, Nathan Gurley and Margaret Gurley, who were proved to have ^{been} born free in this County by Nathan C. Bryant, and Margaret & Fanny Davis who were proved to have been born free in this County by Cary Gay -

The Court believes upon satisfactory proof by a white person that Robert and Benjamin Taylor free persons of mixed blood, residents in this County, are not negroes -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term -
