Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 22^d day of January 1850 from John L. Cooke and Patience H. his wife of the one part to Jacob Williams of the other part. Conveying 40 acres of land more or less - was admitted to record the 15th day of September 1850.

Deed of Bargain and Sale, dated the 29th day of August 1850 from Henning J. Smith and Matthe G. his wife of the one part, to Jeremiah Hensfert of the other part. Conveying 400 acres of land more or less - was admitted to record the 15th day of September 1850.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 2^d day of February 1850 from Miles Pope and Mary at his wife, Isaac St. Davis and Susanna G. his wife, Olivia Kasse Julia A. Joyner, Lewis Kelle and Rebecca his wife, Mary Kasse and Edwin Kasse of the one part, to Jos. St. Barkham of the other part. Conveying 346¹/₂ acres of land more or less - was admitted to record the 20th day of September 1850.

Deed of Release dated the day of September 1850 from Edward to the pending of the one part to Benj. Summers of the other part. Releasing 214 acres of land more or less and also one negro boy conveyed interest for the benefit of John C. Hart. was admitted to record the 28th day of September 1850.

Deed of Bargain and Sale dated the 24th day of September 1850 from Washington L. Reddie and Emma M. his wife of the one part to Wm. J. Davis of the other part. Conveying 300 acres of land more or less - was admitted to record the 30th day of September 1850.

Deed of Mortgage dated the 18th day of September 1850 from John A. Carson to Edwin Fens. Conveying one cream horse, one cart and wheels, twelve head of hogs, crop of corn, fodder & peas - was admitted to record the 1st day of October 1850.

Deed of Trust dated the 1st day of October 1850 from a betwixt David Cogel of the first part, Patrick O'Brien of the second part and William Luskford, Samuel Kelle and Geo. P.W. Thurson of the third part. Conveying 8 head of hogs, crop of corn, fodder, peas, cotton, and potatoes - was admitted to record the 1st day of October 1850.

Deed of Trust dated the 6th day of August 1850 from the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company of the first part to John J. Palmer of the second part. Conveying their road made or to be made, the right of way and the Lands adjoining thereby, together with the superstructure and tracks thereon, and all rails and other materials used thereon &c. - was admitted to record the 3rd day of October 1850.

Deed of Trust dated the 14th day of October 1850 betwixt Wm. B. Kelle of the first part, John Pope of the second part and Eliza Pope of the third part. Conveying crop of corn, fodder, peas, cotton, potatoes, grain & peas, and 23 head of hogs and their increase - was admitted to record the 14th day of October 1850.
