On the motion of Isaac M. Arnold guardian of Virginia C. Reese ordered that Nathaniel Simmons and Mark T. Peete, Executors of Edward L. Simmons render before a Commissioner of this Court an account of the said Edward L. Simmons' guardianship of the said Virginia C. Reese and that the said Commissioner examine, state and settle the said account and make report
