For reasons appearing to the Court, It is ordered that the Orphans of The Poor do bind George Brown, son of Stoney Brown after negro to Catharine Stanison according to Law, and the Court consider that \$20 will be the reasonable annual value of the services of the apprentice in the art, Trade or business which he is to be taught to commence from this day, and the Orphans of the poor by whom this order shall be executed in addition to the indenture of apprenticeship shall take from the trustees bond with satisfactory security in copenary equal to double the value of the services of the apprentice for the whole term payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, conditions to account for the value of such services according to Law.
