For reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that the overseers of the Poor do bind Henry Brown, son of Henry Brown after negro to Catharine Stanisar according to Law. and the Court concur that \$20 will be the reasonable annual value of the services of the apprentice in the art. There or business which he is to be taught to commence from this day. and the overseers of the poor by whom this order shall be executed in addition to the indenture of apprenticeship shall take from the master's bond with satisfaction security in a penalty equal to double the value of the services of the apprentice for the whole term & payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, conditions to account for the value of such services according to Law.
