The Court being of opinion that the said Rebecca Wootson is a person of good moral character and is not likely to become chargeable to any part of the Commonwealth.

Upon the petition of Robert and Benjamin Taylor descendants of a female of the Nottoway Tribe of Indians. This day this cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read together with the report of the Commissioners made at November Term last and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court upon mature consideration doth adopt and confirm said report and order that the said Robert and Benjamin Taylor hold the land in the said report mentioned as their individual and absolute property in full discharge of all their interest and claim in the real estate held in trust for the benefit of the said Nottoway Tribe of Indians. The Court being of opinion that the said Robert and Benjamin Taylor are persons of good moral character and are not likely to become chargeable to any part of the Commonwealth.

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
