The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report.

On the motion of James D. Bryant, guardian of James G. Bryant he is allowed to expend the sum of twenty three dollars per annum for the years 1849 and 1850 of the principal of his said ward's estate for his support, maintenance &c.

On the motion of James D. Bryant guardian of Temperance S. Bryant, he is allowed to expend the sum of eighteen dollars per annum for the years 1849 & 1850 of the principal of his said ward's estate for his support &c.

On the motion of William Edwards guardian of Louisa Vaughan he is allowed to expend the sum of thirty dollars of the principal of his said ward's estate for her support &c.
