

On the petition of Satey Bogeman a descendant of a female of the
 Ottawa Tribe of Indians the Commissioner appointed to ascertain the
 interest of the said Bogeman in the estate lies in trust for the
 benefit of the said tribe of Indians. This day made his report
 and the same coming on again to be heard on the papers formally
 read and the report of Commissioner Parker was argued by
 Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth adjudge, order
 and decree that James W. Parker who is hereby appointed a special
 Commissioner for that purpose power to allot to Satey Bogeman her
 mother and heirs one thirtieth part in value of the real estate lies
 in common by the Ottawa Tribe of Indians and if necessary to
 employ a competent surveyor to assist him, and it doth further
 adjudge order and decree that the trustees for the said tribe
 pay to the said Satey Bogeman the sum of Ten dollars, it being
 the portion of the money belonging to said tribe to which she
 is entitled, and leave is reserved for the said Satey Bogeman
 to apply for her portion of the fund now in suit, whenever
 it shall be recovered and that the said Commissioner report
 to this Court in order for a final decree

 of July next - and report to Court

 this Court to consider the proposals concerning the
 repairing of the South Quay Bridge
