Glover enter into new recognizance himself in the sum of two hundred dollars and two securities each in the sum of one hundred dollars conditioned for the said John M. Glover's personal appearance here on the first day of the next Term of this Court - Whereupon the said John M. Glover with Benjamin E. Daughtrey and Wm. Bairden his securities here in Court solemnly acknowledges himself to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say, the said John M. Glover in the sum of two hundred dollars, and the said Benjamin E. Daughtrey and Wm. Bairden each in the sum of one hundred dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, Lands and tenements, to be levied, for the use of the Commonwealth sundries. Yet upon this condition that if the said John M. Glover shall personally appear here on the first day of the next term of this Court to abide the order of the Court touching the said accusation, and shall not thence depart without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue - and the case is continued till the next Term.
