Sebell be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across Notoway river near Edenwien and those on the embankment on the South side of said river, and to receive the same when completed and report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of the bridge across Cypress Swamp this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded.
