Surley two of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded. & On the motion of John James the executor therein named, who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat^e of said will in due form.

Ordered that Wm J. Sebell, Jos. Jenkins, Harry M. Butts and Lemuel T. Nicholson or any three of them being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods and chattels of Nancy James dec^d, that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

On the motion of Patrick Eales who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Caroline A. M. E. Griffin dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Edmund Kitchin, Wm. Kingston, John B. Boykin, and Thos. E. Jones or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods and chattels of Caroline A. M. E. Griffin dec^d that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

On the motion of Patrick Eales who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis non on the estate of Godwin G. Griffin dec^d in due form.

On the motion of Amos B. Ungahart who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis non on the estate of William Ungahart dec^d in due form.

An Account of the transactions of William J. Sebell, as executor of Nicholas M. Sebell reported by Commissioner Cobb of this Court having lain in the Clerk's Office of this Court for one month and upwards, and the Court proceeding to examine the account and the exceptions thereto filed by the said executor, and the said executor and William A. Bell who is interested in the said account being fully heard by Counsel it is considered by the Court that the said account be re-committed to the said Commissioner with instructions to allow the executor commissions on all the moneys received by him belonging to the estate of his testator. Whereupon on the motion of the said Wm. A. Bell and for good cause shown it is ordered that the said report be removed to the Circuit Court of this County.
