

The Commissioners appointed by this Court to act in conjunction with the Commissioners of Nansemond County Court in receiving proposals for the repairs of the South Quay bridge. This day returned sealed proposals, all of which were rejected by said Court, and thereupon the Court doth appoint James Massey Robert G. Coward and Richard Barrett Commissioners on the part of this County, to consult with the Commissioners on the part of Nansemond County as to the propriety of establishing a ferry at the present site of the South Quay Bridge, and that a copy of this order be certified to the County Court of Nansemond.

The last will and Testament of Eliza T. Wynn dec^d was this day produced to the Court, and further proved by the oath of Mrs M. S. Williamson one of the subscribing witnesses thereto.

John M. Cloon who is committed to the Jail of this County for failing to comply with the order of this Court made against him for the support of two bastard children, of which Eliza both former was delivered is for reasons appearing to the Court discharged from imprisonment.

On the motion of Ezra Beale who is bound in this Court as security for Anthony M. Howell as guardian of Winny Beale; the said Howell is ordered to be summoned here to the first day of the next Term to show cause if any he can, why he should not be required to give a sure bond with security conditions according to Law.

Ordered that John Barham, Wm. R. Worrell and Mills Pope be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge across Blunk's Swamp and to receive the same when completed and make report to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned to the first day of the next Term.
