peas, potatoes & brandy was admitted to record the 21st day of August 1851.

Deed of Marriage Agreement dated the 10th day of September 1851, between Septia
Dawson of the first part, Goodwin S. Cutler of the second part, and Elizabeth Whitehead
of the third part. Conveying 3 feather beds & furniture, 13 head of hogs, 1 loom & pictures,
kitchen & household furniture. was admitted to record the 10th day of September 1851.

Deed of bargain and Sale dated the 5th day of September 1851, from C. F. W. Newcom &
Martha his wife to James L. Bryant. Conveying 244 acres of Land more or
less was admitted to record the 12th day of September 1851.
