James W. Casner who stands charged with felony by him committed in this that he did on the 12th day of August 1857, unlawfully, feloniously and maliciously shoot Gustavus A. Johnson, with intent to maim, disfigure, disable or kill him; this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into before Richard Barrett a Justice of the peace of this County, and on the motion of the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth, and for reasons appearing to the Court, this case is continued until the next Term of this Court.

James W. Casner who stands charged with felony by him committed in this that he did on the 13th day of August 1857, feloniously make his escape from Wm Murphy Constable who had him in custody, the said Casner being charged with felony and committed for such by shooting in Gustavus A. Johnson on the 12th of August, 57 in the County of Sussex with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into before Richard Barrett a Justice of the peace of this County, and the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth with the consent of the Court says he will not further prosecute in this case, and
 ✓ thereupon the said James W. Casner is discharged from further prosecution in this case.

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
