Ordered that James C. Peter, Robert Roland and John Williams be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Jones Bridge across the three creeks, and to receive the same when completed & make due report of the same to Court.

On the motion of Alex Myrick Sheriff of this County, Geo. B. Pope is permitted to qualify as his Deputy. The Court being of opinion that the said Geo. B. Pope is a man of honesty probity and good demeanor, and thereupon he took the several oaths prescribed by Law.

On the motion of Irving Cliffin to alter the road running through his plantation, the Commissioners appointed to view the way for altering said road this day made their report. and the Court doth grant the said Irving Cliffin leave to alter said road as proposed, and appoint Richard Branch, Wm. S. Kinison and Eli Joyner, Commissioners to receive the said road when altered and put in lawful repair and to make report to Court.

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
