

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton continued and held at the Court-house this 18th day of November 1857.

Ordnre that the account of Lewis Sharp amounting to \$2.50, of Rich^d C. Gray amounting to \$3.30 for guarding W^m B. B. only be certified to the auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

W^m O. Briggs who has been hitherto appointed Superintendent of the Board of School Commissioners in and for this County, this day appeared into Court and entered into and acknowledged a bond with security according to Law.

The Clauses awarded in these cases being returned executed on the said defendants, and the said defendants being solemnly called and not appearing, on the motion of the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth the rules made in these cases are made absolute, and leave is given to file Informations upon the said presentments, and prosecute against the said defendants returnable here at the next Quarterly Term of this Court to answer the same.

William Bryant, who stands charged with a felony by him committed in the County of Southampton and within the jurisdiction of this Court, in this, that he did on the 20th day of October 1857, with force and arms in the County aforesaid feloniously and maliciously kill and murder one William Nash, was this day set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and the Court having heard the evidence, are of opinion that the said William Bryant ought to be tried for the offence of which he stands charged before the Circuit Court of Southampton County. And thereupon the said William Bryant is remanded to Jail.

Ant Elizabeth Scott, Littlebury Johnson, and John Bryant severally entered into a recognizance each in the sum of one hundred dollars, conditioned for their appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of the County of Southampton, on the first day of the next Term of that Court to give evidence on behalf of the Commonwealth against W^m Bryant, and not to depart thence with the leave of the said Court.

Ordnre that the
