And the Overseers of the Poor by whom this order is executed, shall take from the Master a bond with good security in a penalty equal to double the value of the services of the apprentice for the whole term, payable and conditions according to Law.

Ordered that the Clerk register Robt. Scott a free negro who was proved to have been born free in this County by James Christie and John Bird who was proved to have been born free in this County by John M. Luley.

On the motion of Nathan B. Bryant. for leave to open a new road from The Meherrin Depot to the Branches Bridge Road. It is ordered that Howell Harris, Edwin Harris and Nathan B. Thomas being sworn for the purpose do view the way proposed for opening said road and report to Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as the public, and especially whether any yard, garden, orchard or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
