Ordered that Joel Prince, Wm Prince & Isaac Davis or any two of them be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Poplar Swamp Bridge near Randall's Mill, and to receive the same when completed and make report to Court.

Ordered that Wm C. Myrick Saml. A. Gordon & Amy T. Bennett or any two of them be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across Poplar Swamp near S. D. Harris and to receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the application of Samuel Drury who produces the sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by Law, License is granted him to keep a house of private entertainment or his house in this County until May Term next. It being the opinion of the Court that he is sober and of good character, and will probably keep a house orderly, useful and such as the Law requires.
