Ordered that Exum Spring be appointed captain of one Mansfield's Nine. Richard Gray, W^m Wellons, Saml. Spring and Augustus Cuttle a patrol to patrol and visit in their neighborhood all negro quarters and other places suspected of having therein unlawful assemblies or such slaves as may stroll from plantation to another without permission for the term of three months

Ordered that the black register Milton White, Maria S. Green, W^m Bailey who were born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Joshua Pritton, Jim Green, Maria Green, Ely Green, Robert Green, Maria Bailey, Robert White, Henry Hill, Ruth Cornwell, Mike Bailey, Patsy Pritton, Robert Bailey, Nancy Drew, Patsy Bailey, Stephen Bailey, Caroline Cornwell and Martha Roberts, who were born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Thomas R. Pritton, Frances Green formerly Crocker who was born free as appears by the testimony of Elizabeth Cornwell and Hannah Green who were born free as appears by the testimony of Thomas R. Pritton, Abram Hollans who was born free as appears from his former register and Sally Smith sometimes called Mann who was born free as appears to the satisfaction of the Court

The order summoning the Justices to this Court to take into consideration the report of the Commissioners appointed to report what repairs are necessary to Clerk's office, Courthouse, Jail &c of this County being returned unexecuted and the Court taking into consideration the said report rejected it and adopted the following: 1st that the Courthouse be returned and that the shutters that are broken off be replaced; that the plastering be repaired and the walls be whitewashed; that eight benches be made for the gallery and that a lock be placed on the door of the Courthouse; and that the roof the Clerk's office be repaired; and that the windows and doors of the Jail be painted; that a railing be extended from the bar on either side to the walls of the Courthouse and that a door be made on each side through the railing; and also that the Spar be nicely cleaned up and that the railing around the Jail be painted with some cheap paint; say tax and Spanish are appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest bidder the repairs as specified above and receive the same when completed and make report to Court
