The following certificate of the qualification of John Baskin as a Justice of the peace of this County, was this day returned and ordered to be entered in the minutes of the proceedings of the day, To-wit:

Ordered that the account of Littleton R. Edwards Clerk of this Court amounting to Seventeen Dollars & fifty cents be certified to the auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

It is ordered to be certified that it has this day been proved to the satisfaction of the Court by the oaths of George W. Spring and James B. Love who are credible persons, that said Love to whom County Land warrant No 37,638 for 80 acres was issued by James C. Heath Commissioner of Pensions for the United States of America, died on the 13th day of July in the year 1851 leaving Wiley Love & John J. Love his only heirs at Law, all of whom are of lawful age.

The last will and Testament of Lewis Harris dec'd. was this day proved by the oaths of David Prince & Henry Biggs two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of James Harris the executor therein named who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law in the penalty of twenty five thousand dollars. Certificate is granted him for obtaining apportion of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that Thomas B. Lowell, C. A. Island, David Prince & Thos. M. Newcom or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Lewis Harris dec'd. that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

Ordered that the estate of Mrs B. Newcomer be committed to the honor of the Sheriff of this County (Saml. Wells) to be administered according to Law.

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
