

Account current and commissioners report of William Justins' guardianship of Georgiana Barkham, of Reginald J. Barkham and of Augustus D. Barkham, of Davis Baynards administration on the estate of John Phillips dec'd of Saml S. Minton's administration on the estate of Nathan Whitley dec'd of William J. Sobrell's executorial proceedings on the estate of Nicholas M. Sobrell dec'd and of Robert S. Pielow's administration on the estate of Matthew Scott dec'd having severally been on month and upwards in the Clerk's office and there being no exceptions thereto were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

An account of all demands or debts against Matthew Scott, dec'd, on his estate, passed before Wm. Cobb, one of the commissioners of the County Court of Southampton County, having been on month and upwards in the Clerk's office and there being no exceptions thereto, was examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded. And it is ordered that Robert S. Pielow the personal representative of the said Matthew Scott, dec'd, apply to the payment of the debts and demands appearing to be due by the said account, after reserving five dollars and twenty cents to meet any further expenses of administration may come against the said estate, the estate of the decedent in his hands, if so much there be, if not, that he apply it pro rata to the payment of the debts - provided as aforesaid.

Orders that the estate of Robert Davis be committed to the hands of Saml. Kello, Sheriff of this County to be administered according to Law.

The commissioners appointed to view the causeway of the second Mill Bridge and to report to court what repairs are necessary to the said causeway and also this day made their report, and it is ordered that S. S. H. Burgess, Saml. Kello of Wm. Thompson be appointed commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs as reported necessary by the commissioners in their report, and to receive the same when completed and make report to court.

On the motion of Harrison S. Moore who is bound in this Court as security for Hemming S. Smith for the faithful discharge of his trusts as guardian of Anna J. Harrison for a new bond with security. It appearing to the satisfaction of this Court that the said Hemming S. Smith has had legal notice of this motion, he was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that he appear here instantly and enter into a new bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars with sufficient security, and the said Hemming S. Smith failing to enter into the bond as aforesaid, it is ordered that he be discharged from his office or trust as guardian aforesaid. Whereupon the Court ordered Harrison S. Moore guardian to the said Anna Harrison and thereupon he gave bond and security according to Law.
