

To reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that the overseer of the poor do bind Jane Powell aged seven years, Peter Powell, aged five years and Master Powell aged three years children, ~~children~~ of Susan Powell de: free negro. to Isaac M. Amos. And the Court consider that \$10 will be the reasonable annual value of the services of Jane for the last four years of her apprenticeship that \$10 will be the reasonable annual value of the services of Peter for the last six years of his apprenticeship and that \$10 will be the reasonable annual value of the services of Master Powell for the last two years of her apprenticeship in the art, Trade or business which they are to be Taught, to be resumed to be paid to them as they respectively become free. And the overseer of the poor by whom this order shall be executed shall take of the Master bonds in a sum sufficiently sufficient for the payment of the sums for which the apprentices are respectively bound.

On the motion of David Baugh Committee of Martha K. Stephenson a female - he is allowed to sell one of the negroes of the said Martha K. Stephenson and to apply the proceeds for her support at the rate of one hundred dollars per annum for five years.

James H. Person is appointed surveyor of the road from Flat Swamp bridge to Newflet L. Bonds Shop, and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

It is ordered that Calvin J. Stephenson surveyor of the road be summoned here to the next term of this Court to show cause, if any he can, why he should not appear from his office as surveyor aforesaid.

Ordered that the Clerk register Edige Low free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the Testimony of John M. Emly.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the justices of the peace of this County to the next term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety of requalifying themselves for the performance of their duties in Court.

On the motion of Henry B. Henry, Guardian of Aurelia Nichols he is allowed to sell a Horse belonging to the said Aurelia and to apply the proceeds for her support.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
