The order made at the last term of this Court summoning Calvin Stephenson here today to show cause if any he can why he should not be removed as Surveyor of the road is continued until the next term of this Court.

The Commissioners appointed to examine the embankment at the Cypress bridge this day rendered their report, and it is ordered that Archer Vick, Bennett Searns, & Seth H. Bishop be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of said embankment and receive the same when completed and make report to Court: provided the said repairs do not exceed the sum of three hundred dollars.

The Commissioners appointed to receive sealed proposals for the rebuilding of the Cypress bridge this day returned the proposals to Court, and the Court proceeding to examine the said proposals, accept the proposal of Edwards Beaton for the rebuilding of said bridge for the sum of seven hundred dollars, and Archer Vick, Bennett Searns & Seth H. Bishop are appointed Commissioners to reduce to writing a contract between the said Edwards Beaton and the County, which contract they shall return to Court.

Carry B. Gay is appointed Surveyor of the road from Thiffins bridge to Farmers bridge in the name of Benjamin Dutton executed, and it is ordered that the usual laws do work thereon.

Ordered that CO^{rs} Cowen, John Cobb, Thomas Ridley, Harrison P. Pope, & James H. Parker be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or extension (as they shall deem best) of the embankment on the south side of the Nottoway river near Jerusalem, and the repairs of the Indian bridge and receive the same when completed and make report to Court.
