Ordered that the accounts of Wm. J. Stephenson Constable amounting to nine dollars & fifty cents, of Thomas S. Dole amounting to four dollars and fifty five cents of George W. Bradshaw amounting to two dollars be certified to the auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

Ordered that the clerk register Olisha Scott (foreigner) who was born free in this county as appears by the testimony of Robert S. Prettow.
