 Court is given her to bind out her son James Jones to
 Thomas J. Butler.

William Beale who is accused in oath by Peggy Beale an unmarried
 white woman of this County of being the father of a female
 bastard child whereof she was delivered on the 9th day
 of April 1853, this day appeared in Court in discharge
 of his recognizance entered into before Joseph B. Gillette
 a Justice of the peace of this County and the Court
 having heard the evidence adduced in this cause, are of
 opinion that the said Wm Beale is the father of the said
 bastard child and it is ordered that he pay to the
 consent of the Court for the maintenance of the said child
 the sum of fifteen dollars annually from the 9th day of April
 1853, until the said child arrives to the age of eight
 years in 1861, unless it sooner dies, and that he also
 pay the costs of this prosecution, and that he execute
 bond with sufficient security to comply with the above
 order. And thereupon he interceded in the penalty of
 two hundred & forty dollars with Arthur Gannon his
 security conditioned as the Law directs.
