This day, these causes came on to be again heard in the papers formerly read and on the report of the Commissioners made at the last term of this Court, to which reports no exceptions having been filed, were argued by counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court approving and confirming said reports, doth adjudge, order and decree that the same be held firm, stable & binding between all the parties forever, and that the costs of these suits be proportionally borne by all the parties.

The order summoning the Justices of this County to take into consideration the propriety of paying the Sheriff of this County being returned executed and a majority of the Justices being present and they taking the subject into consideration fix the Tax at one hundred & twenty five dollars for the year next ensuing.

The Court designate the two quarterly terms held in March & August in each year as the two quarterly terms of this Court for the trial of civil cases; and also they designate the same terms as the two quarterly terms for the grand jury terms of this Court.

It was ordered on the application of the Petersburg and Jerusalem Plank Road Company (the Justices of the County having been duly summoned to take the subject into consideration) that the said Company have liberty to occupy the public road leading from Jerusalem to the County line of Sussex near Littleton.

On the following conditions, to-wit: that the people of the County of Southampton shall be permitted to use the road of the said Company for all purpose of neighborhood travel with horses, pleasure carriages, carts and wagons and for the further purpose of going to and returning from their mills, blacksmiths shop &c. within the limits for which the liberty is granted & them to occupy the public road free from all charge of toll.

On the motion of Tom, Susan, Lucy & Julia Harrison negroes manipulated under the will of Henry Harrison dec'd it is ordered that the Justices of this County be summoned here to the September term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety of allowing them to remain in this County.
