

Orders that the order committing the estate of Jane Bittle to the sheriff of this County be set aside.

On the motion of Alfred J. Bittle who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him in obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Jane Bittle dec'd with the will annexed in due form.

Ordered that Allen Stephenson, Drury Dowd and Jesse Canoll bring sworn for the purpose as appraisers all the goods or chattels of Jane Bittle dec'd that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

The order made at the last term of this Court summoning the Justices here today to take into consideration the propriety of adopting the act of Assembly passed March 30. 1853, entitled "an act to procure in Law in the County of Louisa and certain other Counties therein mentioned" being returned executed and a majority of the Justices being present and they taking the subject into consideration adopted the said act, and they proceeding to divide the County into precincts for procossioning the lands of every person in the County do order and direct that the County be divided into 39 districts as follows:

- Precinct No. 1. From Nottoway river, up the great Swamp to Crafford's road down said road to Nottoway river and down the said river to the beginning.
- " 2. From the northside of the Flat Swamp, from the old Parish line, thence to the Robin branch, and up that to the Angelica Swamp, up the same to Robin branch, and up that to the Flat Swamp, and down the Flat Swamp.
- " 3. Bounded by the Meherrin river and the Flat Swamp and from the old parish line to the Flat Swamp, and so up to Thomas Coe's.
- " 4. Between Nottoway River, Cary's bridge road, the Three Creeks and the Relfield road.
- " 5. All the lands lying east of the Barkham Swamp, Nottoway River the Indians line, and the Main Road sometimes called the Creek Road.
- " 6. From the Angelica Swamp bridge, up the Swamp to Townsend's branch up the said branch to the Angelica Chappell, then down Barrow Road to the head of Buckhorn, down that to the new Road, and by the said road to the beginning.
- " 7. From the Mouth of Reddy's branch to the head of Groves branch down that to the Ross's Meadow, up that to Robin's branch, up that to the head of Angelica Swamp and down the said Swamp to the beginning.
- " 8. From Robin's branch up the southside of the Three Creeks to the County line, to the Meherrin River, down the said River to Thomas Coe's land, and thence to Robin branch.
- " 9. From the former parish line down the Flat Swamp to Crafford's road and along the said road to the County line up the said line to the Greenwell line, up that to the old parish line along the said line to the beginning.
