Kitchen, & John Griffin do view the way proposed for opening said road and report the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as the public if such road shall be as proposed, and especially whether any yard, garden or orchard or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken.

On the motion of Nathan Debuyant who made oath gave bond and security according to Law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Anderson Pope dec'd under ^{the} seal.

Ordered that Benjamin LeMeale, Brown Davis & J. C. Powell, ^{and} soon for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Anderson Pope dec'd. that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
