

On the motion of Sam Harrison, free negro, emancipated ^{since} the first day of May eighteen hundred & six for permission to remain in this State & to reside in this County: The order made at the last July Term of this Court directing the Sheriff to summon the Justices of this County to this Term to consider this application, being returned executed by a majority of them being present and voting on the question, and it appearing that notice of this motion was posted at the Courthouse door for at least two months immediately preceding and the attorney for the Commonwealth being present, and representing the State as Counsel. The Court upon mature consideration of the facts in the case ~~refused~~ both refuse the said permission to the said Sam Harrison.

Ordered that Benjamin McCallister, Edwin Harris & J. T. Powell, being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Anderson Pope dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
