

Ordered that the Clerk register Maria Warren free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Thomas Lavin, and Vincent Hunt free negro, who was free in this County as appears by the testimony of Benjamin Bryant & James Hargrave, free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of John J. Adams.

Ordered that W^m D. Bryant be appointed freeholder in Precinct No 24, in the room of Richard Parker, deceased.

Ordered that the estate of James Bass dec^d be committed to the hands of Saml. Kells Sheriff of this County to be administered according to Law.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in hands not otherwise appropriated pay to Harrison & Moore of W^m Cobb each the sum of one hundred and thirty five Dollars for repairs to the embankment at Cypress bridge across Nottoway river and fifteen Dollars each for extra work on the said embankment.

The Commissioners appointed to let out to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the embankment at Cypress bridge across Nottoway river & to receive the same when completed, this day made their report.

W^m W. Riggs who is elected superintendent of Schools of this County for the year commencing the first day of January 1854, this day appeared in Court and entered into and acknowledged a bond conditioned according to Law.

Ordered that Peter Edwards, Ro. S. Jones, James P. Jones & Geo. James or any three of them being sworn for the purpose and appearance all the goods & chattels of James Fisher dec^d that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

Ordered that the Clerk register Elizabeth Bailey free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Harrison L. Hurrell.

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
