

503 On the motion of Patience Ailes, free negro, it is ordered that John Barham be summoned
her to the next term of this Court to show cause, if any he can, why the
Indemnity binding Jas. Westley & Benja. Harrison Ailes children of the said Pa-
tience Ailes to him should not be cancelled.

On the motion of Benjamin Drury, Robert S. Jones, Thomas J. Bishop &
Elijah Jagers, Justices of this County, it is ordered that John Champ
who was appointed Trustee for his wife & children under a decree of
this Court at December Term 1853, be summoned to appear to her
at the next term of this Court to show cause if any he can why
he should not be ruled to give bond & security for the faithful discharge
of his duties as Trustee aforesaid.

Ordered that the several accounts of T. J. Mahone, Jailor of this County, one
amounting to \$2.30 + one to \$14.90 + one to \$11.30 + one to \$12.50. be certified
to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

Present James Holmes Justice

Nicholas Ailes, free negro, who stands charged with felony by him committed in this
County, and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this, that he did on the 13th
day of October A.D. 1853, in the said County on one Susan Glover feloniously
make an assault and on the said Susan Glover in bodily fear, did feloniously
put and deliver to the amount of thirty three dollars (and seventy five cents
and one piece of gold coin of the value of two dollars and fifty cents (all
making the amount of thirty six dollars and twenty five cents) the property and money of
the said Susan Glover from the person and against the will of the said Susan
Glover feloniously and violently did steal, take and carry away was this day
set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and being arraigned
pleaded not guilty: And the Court having heard the evidence, are unanimously of
opinion that the said Nicholas Ailes is guilty of the offence wherewith he
stands charged: Therefore it is considered by the Court, that the said
Nicholas Ailes be imprisoned in the Penitentiary of this Common-
wealth for the term of Three years, therein to be kept and treated
as the Law directs. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County
shall as soon as may be convenient after the adjournment of this Court
remove and securely convey the said Nicholas Ailes from the jail
of this County to the said Penitentiary of this Commonwealth
and there deliver him to the Superintendent thereof. And the said
Nicholas Ailes is remanded to jail.

Ordered that Thomas B. Howell, Parker D. Stay, & Stith H. Bishop be appointed
appraisers, after being sworn for the purpose, to appraise all the goods and chattels
of John C. Beale dec'd that may be produced to them & make return
of the same.

On the motion of Jas. B. Wellons, it is ordered that the estate of Penitentiary
dec'd be committed to the hands of Saml. Kello Sheriff of this County
to be administered according to Law.
