in repair the embankment at Cypress bridge for the
sum of three years.

Ordered that

James W. Murfee having obtained an attachment against the goods and
chattels of John T. Parker, his tenant, for \$50 payable the 1st
day of January 1851, & for \$50 payable the 19th day of
December 1851, and W^m Murphy one of the Constables of this County
by virtue thereof, attached a Lot of Corn & fodder, 4 Sons @ 19
250 lbs., one Cow & 2 yearlings, one red ox, one Cart & wheels,
one old Augy, one Gray Horse, & one Jersey Wagon. This day
came the Plaintiff by his attorney (and the defendant not
appearing), it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff
recover against the defendant Parker, the sum of \$50 with
legal interest from the 1st day of January 1851, & \$50 with
legal interest from the 19th day of December 1851, of his
costs by him in this behalf suspended. (and that the constable
make sale of the goods aforesaid (and out of the pro-
ceeds of sale pay off & satisfy) this judgment, and the
balance if any remain to the defendant Parker (and
return an account of sales to Court).

The Court doth certify that Levi Hamley is the legally
qualified guardian of John H. Hamley & Benjamin F. Hamley
minor children of Thomas Hamley deceased, it appearing to
the Court to be for the interest of said infants, the Court
doth order that the said guardian sell for the highest
price he can obtain a bounty Land warrant for forty
acres No. 95-492 issued under the act of Congress of
Sept^r 28th 1850, to said infants for their service
in the war of 1812.
