

Harrison D. Moore, Brunette Servant of W^m Cold are appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the keeping in repair the embankment at Cypress bridge for the term of three years.

James W. Murfee having obtained an attachment against the goods and chattels of John S. Parker, his tenant, for \$50 payable the 1st day of January 1854, & for \$50 payable the 14th day of December 1854, and W^m Murfee one of the Constables of this County by virtue thereof, attached a Lot of Corn & fodder, 4 Sows and 19 pigs, one Cow & 2 yearlings, one red ox, one Cart & wheels, one old Cuggy, one Gray Horse, & one Jersey Wagon. This day came the Plaintiff by his attorney (and the Defendant not appearing), it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the defendant Parker, the sum of \$50 with legal interest from the 1st day of January 1854, & \$50 with legal interest from the 14th day of December 1854, of his costs by him in this behalf expended. And that the Constable make sale of the goods aforesaid and out of the proceeds of sale pay & satisfy this judgment, and the balance if any restore to the defendant Parker and return an account of sales to Court.

The Court doth certify that Levi Hambley is the legally qualified guardian of John & Benjamin S. Hambley minor children of Thomas Hambley dec'd & it appearing to the Court to be for the interest of said infants, the Court doth order that the said guardian sell for the highest price he can obtain a bounty Land warrant for forty acres No. 95492 issued under the act of Congress of Sept^r 28th 1850, to said infants for their father's service in the war of 1812.
