On the motion of Lucy Ann Parks to cancel the Indentures binding her children Diana & Henry to W^m Rinford. It is ordered that W^m Rinford be summoned here to the next term of this Court to show cause if any he can why the said Indentures should not be cancelled.

On the motion of Joel Harris who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of David L. Harris dec'd in due form.

On the motion of Stephen A. Goodwyn who made oath & gave bond & security according to Law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Matthew Gilliam dec'd in due form.
