On the motion of Nathaniel Simmons who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edward S. Simmons dec'd in due form of Law.

On the motion of Joel Harris & A. W. Norflut and for reasons appearing to the Court they are excused from serving further during this term as jurors for the trial of civil cases.

Ordered that the Clerk register Theophana Evans free negro who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Joseph Whitehead.

The Jurors in Precincts Nos 4, 31, 17, 29 & 33 this day returned their reports which are ordered to be recorded.
