Deed of Trust dated the 29th day of June 1851, from Ispe Cobb to Matthew W. Vaughan to secure William Murfee - Conveying Land and personal property, was admitted to record June 30th 1851.

Deed of Trust dated the 1st day of July 1851, from John J. Johnson to James M. Corbett to secure Irvin W. Duck & Robert D. Marshall - conveying personal property - was admitted to record 1st July 1851, 10 o'clock A. M.
