Deed of bargain & sale dated the 19th day of August 1854, from Joseph W. Smith & wife to Alfred Holmsted, conveying land & personal property, was admitted to record, August 22nd 1854.

Deed of Trust dated the 30th day of August 1854, from Arthur M. Chalmers to Benjamin Bryant, conveying personal property, to secure Elijah Joyner, was admitted to record, August 30th 1854.

Deed of Trust dated the day of August 1854, from Josiah Joyner (of Sink) to Saml. Kello, conveying personal property in trust to secure John M. Guley, was admitted to record, September 3rd 1854.

Account of Sales dated the day of of the property of Orson Branch by Almon Branch trustee, was admitted to record September 8th 1854.

Deed of Loan dated the 2nd day of September 1854, from Samuel Branch to Sally Branch, conveying personal property, was admitted to record, September 5th 1854.

Deed of Trust dated the 5th day of September 1854, from Frank Hobbs to W^m H. Briggs, conveying personal property, was admitted to record September 5th 1854.

Virginia Dwyer having nominated Robert H. Mason as her guardian before a Justice of the peace of this County, the Court doth appoint him as her guardian. Thereupon he gave bond & security according to law.

Ordered that S. A. W. Henson, Richard J. Darrow, W^m Rogers and James Schell (any two of whom may act) be appointed Commissioners to let the lowest undertaker for the term of three or two years at their discretion, the keeping in proper order the embarkment or embarkments near Jerusalem.

On the motion of J. W. D. Williamson it is ordered that the estate of Jesse A. Williamson be committed to the hands of Saml. Kello Sheriff of this County to be administered according to law.
