Benkman dec'd having severally laid out month & upwards in the clerk's office and there being no exceptions thereto, were severally examined, confirmed & ordered to be recorded.

Account current and Commissioner's reports of Joseph H. Davis's guardianship of Helen D. Reese and of Rosa Reese, having severally laid out month & upwards in the clerk's office and there being no exceptions thereto, were severally examined and it appearing that the said guardian has made disbursements beyond the annual income of his said wards' estates (and the Court being satisfied that such disbursements were actually made and were judicious and proper, doth allow the same, and confirm and order said accounts to be recorded.

Ordered that W. A. Jones, James Harris, W. T. Jones & Thos B. Powell or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Kinchen Williams dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same

Ordered that Irwin Griffin, Benjamin McNeill, & Ed. Jones be appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Black Creek bridge & to receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the motion of Peter J. Holmes he is exempt from the payment of all Taxes & levies on this negroman Harrison he being sold & informed.
