Deed of bargain & sale dated the 15th day of September 1854, from W^m J. Sebell to James A. Edlath, Isaac M. Arnold, Daniel W. Cobb, W^m H. Nicholson & W^m J. Sebell, Trustees, conveying one acre of land, was admitted to record the 12th day of October 1854.

Deed of bargain & sale dated the 7th day of September 1854, from Joel Vick & wife to Lewis W. Cornell, conveying Land, was admitted to record October 12th 1854.

Deed of bargain & sale dated the 12th day of October 1854, from Robert W. Sevens to Bennett, conveying Land & negroes, was admitted to record October 14th 1854.

Deed of bargain & sale dated the 14th day of October 1854, from John M. Smiley to Robert Sevens, conveying fifty acres of land more or less, was admitted to record, October 14th day of October 1854.

Deed of bargain & sale dated the 28th day of December 1854, from John J. Prince & wife to Benjⁿ A. Bailey Junior, conveying 621 acres of land more or less, was admitted to record the 14th day of October 1854.

Deed of bargain & sale dated the 29th day of November 1853, from John Y. Mason & wife to Benjⁿ A. Bailey, conveying Land, was admitted to record the 16th day of October 1854.

Deed of Trust dated the 16th day of October 1854, from Frank Hobbs & wife to W^m Musie Toosem & Co. W. Sevens, conveying mixed property, was admitted to record the 16th day of October 1854.

Power of Attorney dated the 6th day of November 1854, from W^m B. Bramley to his wife Ann C. Bramley, was admitted to record the 17th day of November 1854.
