

10th W^m Holt, a Commissioner of this Court having returned an account of the debts and demands of M^r J. Schell @mer. of Micajah B. Cole dec'd, and also an account of all debts or demands against Micajah B. Cole dec'd, or his estate, and said account being laid in the Clerk's office one month and upwards, and no exceptions having been filed thereto are confirmed by the Court (and ordered to be recorded) and it appearing to the Court from said account that there are not sufficient assets in the hands of the said M^r J. Schell @mer. of Micajah B. Cole dec'd, sufficient to pay all the debts against the estate of the said Micajah B. Cole dec'd, it is adjudged, ordered (and decreed) that the said Commissioner appraise the amount due from the said Administrator amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid, that he ascertain the amount due each (and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially facts & documents pertinent to himself or which he may be required so to do by either of the parties.

On the motion of John E. Nicholson who made oath and gave bond security according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration de bonis non with the will annexed of Jane Biddle dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Peter Edwards, John E. Brown, Nathan N. Thomas and Mark A. James be appointed Commissioners (any three of whom may act) to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the Flat Swamp bridge at Nelson & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

11 Ordered that Garrison P. Pope, Jasper S. Busham, Ben E. Pope, James W. Parker and W^m Powers (any three of whom may act) be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge across a Holloway river at Jerusalem, (if they deem such repairs necessary) & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

The last will and Testament of Joel Prince, dec'd, was this day proved by the oaths of John Williams, Oliver M. Sykes & Wm Prince, the subscribing witnesses thereto (and ordered to be recorded) and on the motion of Sam'l L. Hood the Executor therein named who made oath (and together with James E. Peters & Benjamin Prince his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency entered into (and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

11 Ordered that James E. Peters, John Williams, Sam'l Drury, James Drury & Joe G. Mayes (or any three of them) being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods or chattels (and real estate of Joel Prince dec'd that may be produced to them to make due return of the same.
