

20th W. Holt, a Commissioner of this Court having returned an account of the debts and demands against Mirajah B. Cole dec'd, and also an account of all having lain in the Clerk's office, no month and upwards, and no exceptions having been filed thereto are confirmed by the Court (and ordered to be recorded) and it appearing to the Court from said account that there are not sufficient assets in the hands of the said Wth J. Holt (Admin^r of Mirajah B. Cole dec'd, orward to pay all the debts against the estate of the said Mirajah B. Cole dec'd, it is adjudged, ordered and decreed that the said Commissioner apportion the amount due from the said Administrator among the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid, that he ascertain the amount due each and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required so to do by either of the parties.

On the motion of John E. Nicholson who made oath and gave bond security according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration de bonis non with the will annexed of Jane Biddle dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Peter Edwards, John A. Dawson, Nathan N. Thomas and Mark A. James be appointed Commissioners (any three of whom may act) to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the Great Swamp bridge at Nelson & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that Harrison P. Pope, Jasper S. Parker, Ren E. Pope, James W. Parker, and Wth Powers (any three of whom may act) be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge across Hatterway River at Jerusalem, (if they deem such repairs necessary) & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

The last will and Testament of Joel Prince, dec'd, was this day proved by the oaths of John Williams, Oliver M. Sykes & Wth Prince, the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Saml. C. Hood the executor therein named who made oath and together with James C. Peters of Benjamin Prince his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.

Ordered that James C. Peters, John Williams, Saml. Drury, James Drury & Jos. G. Mayo (or any three of them) bring soon for the purpose, do appraise all the goods or chattels and real estate of Joel Prince dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
