On the motion of Joshua Pittlow who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Elizabeth Johnson dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Robert Pittlow, Joseph C. Gillette and Jordan Edwards being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of Elizabeth Johnson dec^d. that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Caroline Scott, free negro, the consent of the Court is granted her to bind her infant children, Julius, Orient, Amanda, Louisa and Angeline to Demasius L. Dolis.
