Deed of gift dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1855, from Edward C. Lempler to Joshua Lempler, conveying 350 acres of land, more or less, was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of gift dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1855, from Edward C. Lempler to Augustus Lempler, conveying 890 acres of land, more or less, was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of bargain and sale dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1855, from Joel Harris wife to James D. Westbrook, conveying Land, was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of bargain and sale dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of 1855 from James Harris, Special Commissioner of to Eveline B. Sharp, conveying Land, was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of trust dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1855, from Benj<sup>n</sup> H. Davis to John Griffin to secure Demasus L. Doles, conveying personal property was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of bargain and sale dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1855 from John Hines to Demasus L. Doles, conveying 53 acres of land, more or less, was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of trust dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1854, from Nancy Whitefield to Thomas J. Bishop to secure Dr. D. Butler, conveying land and personal property was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of bargain and sale dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1855 from Jacob Thomas wife to Edward Beard, conveying mixed estate, was admitted to record, April 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.

Deed of bargain and sale dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1855, from W<sup>m</sup> Newson Olden to Caswell Kevill, conveying 133 acres of land more or less, was admitted to record, May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1855.
